

Safe Recommendation Guide

Which safe is right for the customer?

Cash handling procedures and sales volume dictate which safe model will meet requirements. The following will help in gathering intelligence to recommend the right safe (configuration and feature set)

1. Cash sales per day for the last 30 days?
2. Do cash handling procedures require the need to store and dispense rolled coin/ cash?
3. Is cash picked up by an armored car service provider?
4. How often does money get deposited at the bank?
5. Is the retailer receiving provisional credit, or expecting to receive provisional credit in the future?
6. Where will the safe be installed?
7. Is there a seasonal aspect or future planning aspect that could affect your deposit?

Cash Levels - Recommended Safe Fit

\$ 500.00 - \$ 3,000.00 dollars cash per day:

1. Cash Drop only: CSC -1200, CSC-1290 (But only after \$ 2500.00), Model 2461 or 2462 (if they want another validator as back up - they won't need it for volume),
2. Cash Drop and Change Dispensing: Model 7301 or Model 7101

\$ 3,000.00 - \$ 4,500.00 dollars per day:

1. Cash drop Only: CSC 1290 / 2200, 2290, Model 2491 or Model 2462
2. Cash Drop and Change Dispensing: Model 7301, 7302, or 7391 or Model 7101, 7102 or 7191

\$ 4,500.00 - \$ 7,500.00 dollars per day:

1. Cash drop Only: Models: 2462, 2492
2. Cash Drop and Change Dispensing: Model 7302, 7372, 7391 (ONLY \$4-5,000.00), 7392 or Model 7102, 7172, 7191 (ONLY \$4-5,000.00), 7192 or 7900 series (but really only recommended if doing Provisional Credit or having a specific Change Fund reader)

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\$ 7,500.00 + dollars per day:

1. Cash drop Only: Models: 2462, 2492
2. Cash Drop and Change Dispensing: Model 7372, 7392, Model 7172, 7192 7900 series safes.

Cassette Capacity

Capacity is dependent on how often cash is removed from the cassettes.

The customer has the choice of 1200 Note Cassettes or 2200 Note Cassettes. The Industry standard for cash drops made into the bill validators average \$17.00. Each 1200 note cassette would hold approximately \$ 20,400. And a 2200 Note cassette would hold approximately \$ 37,400 per cassette.
